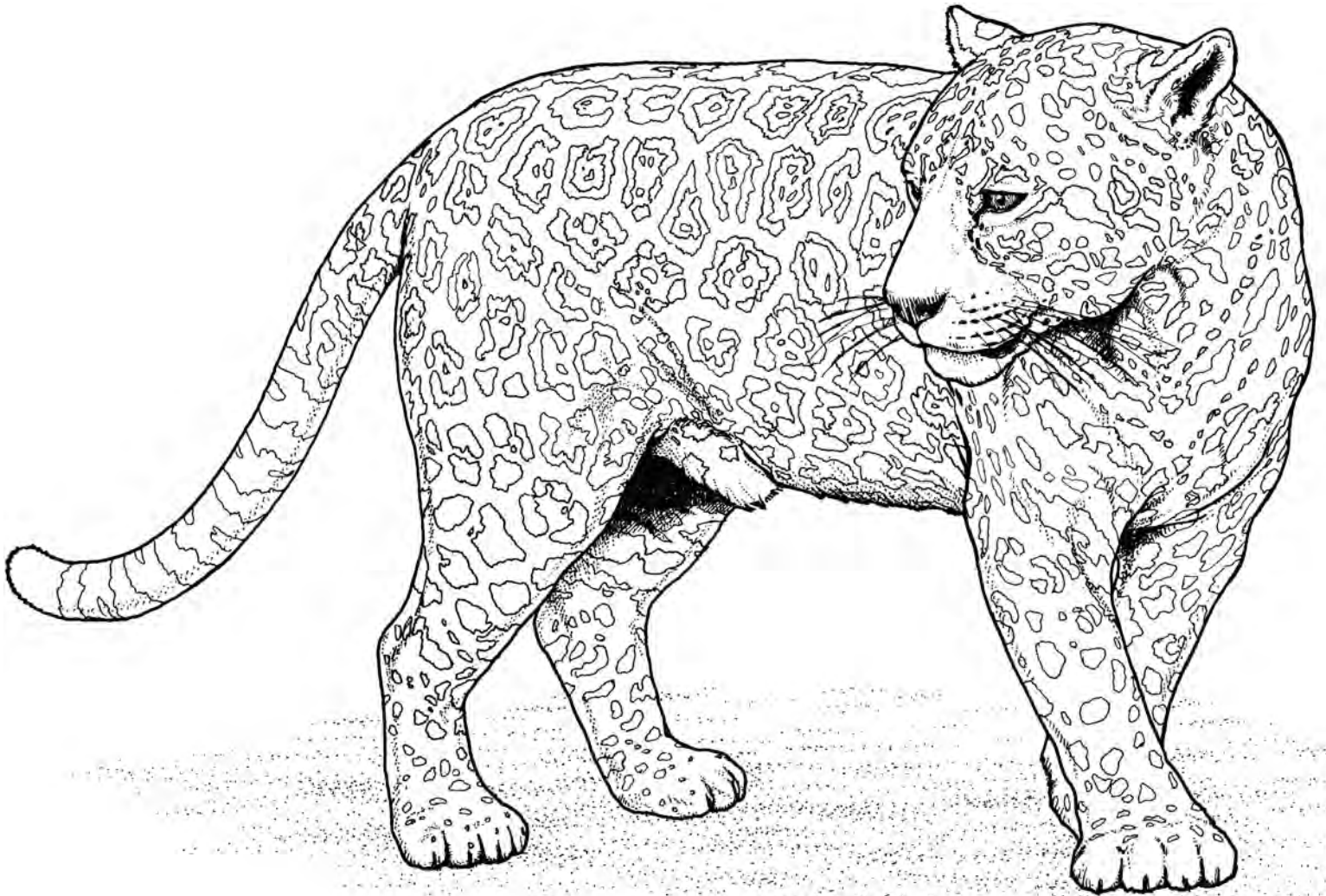

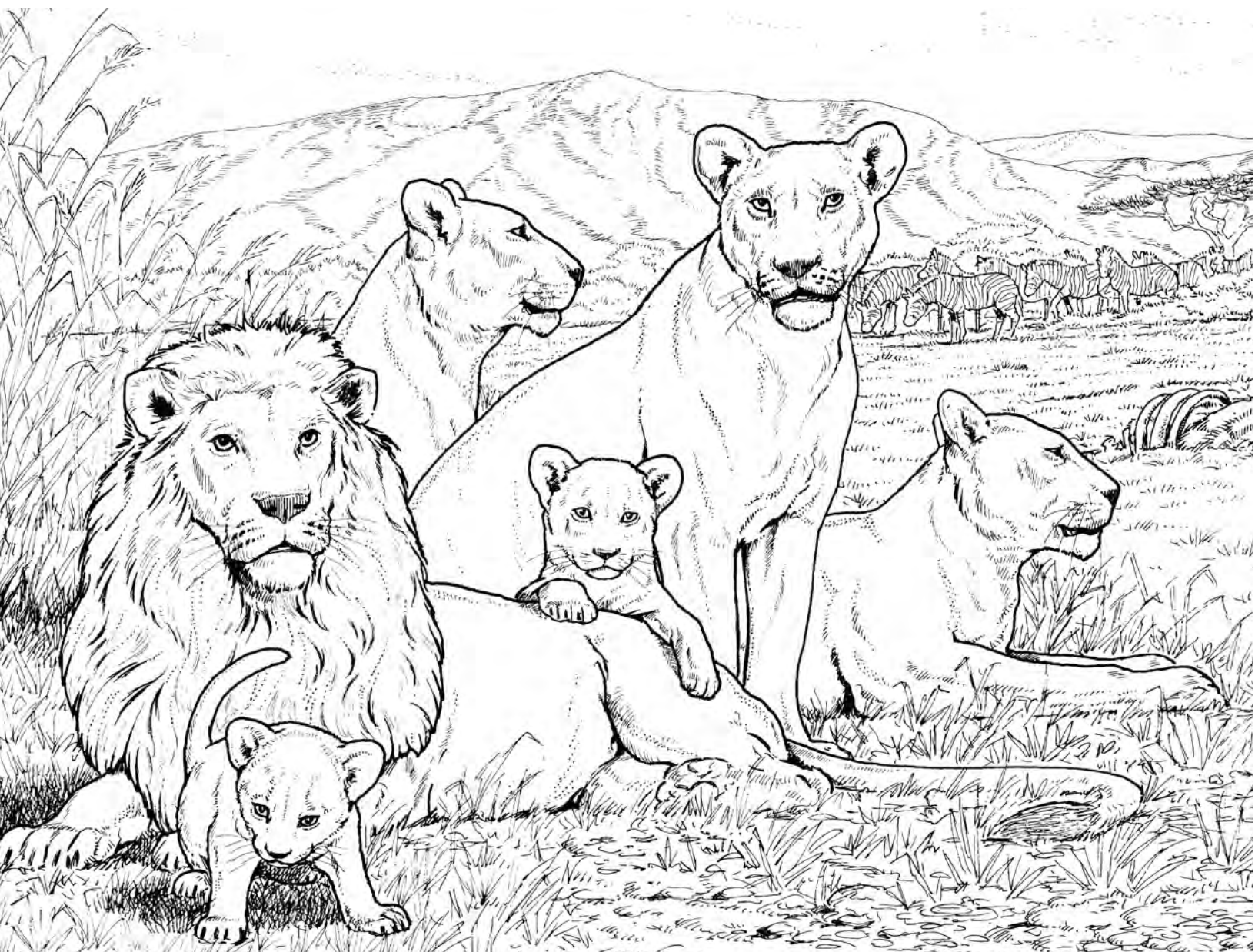
RANGE

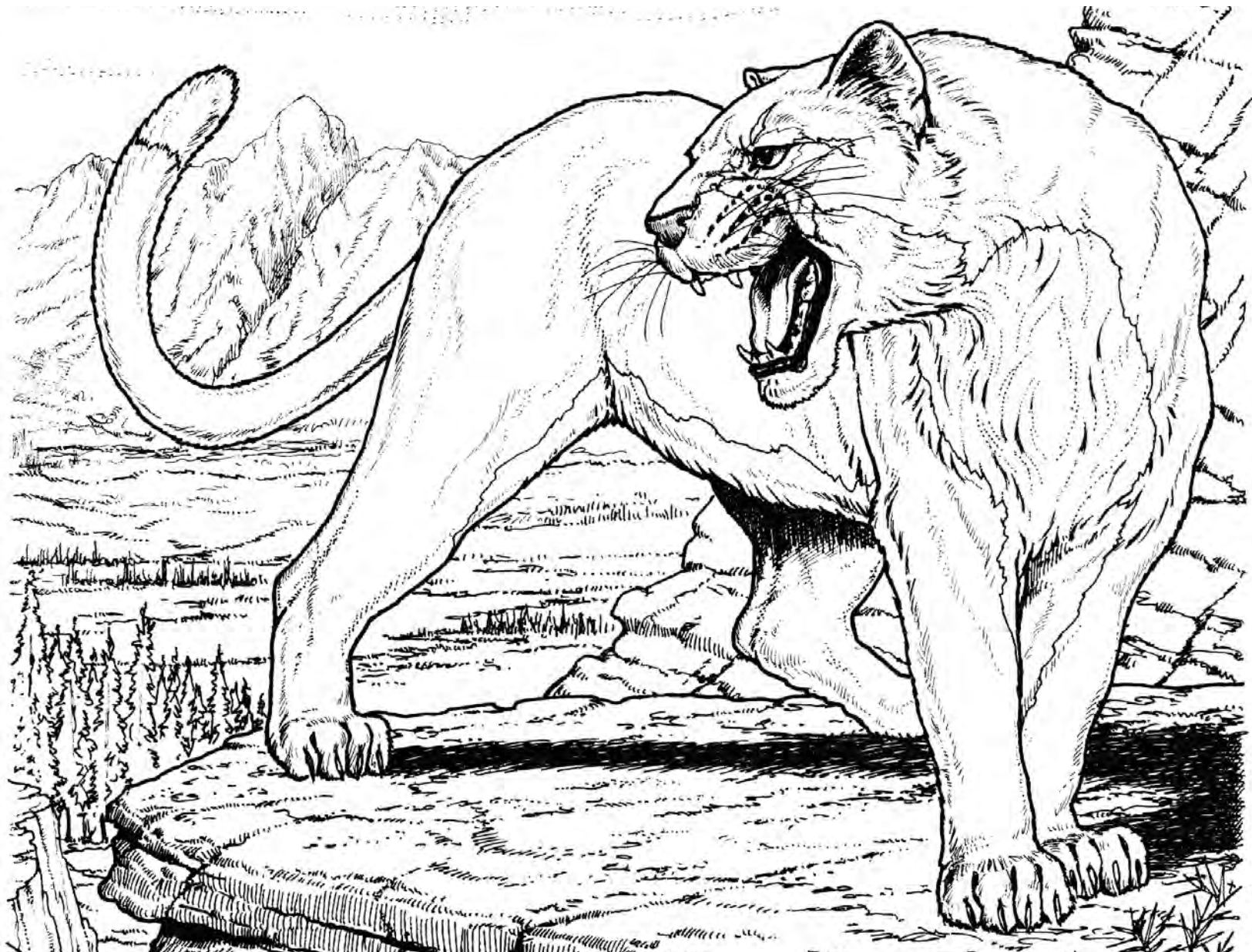
RANGE

RANGE

Largest north-south distribution of any terrestrial mammal in the western hemisphere. Ranges from British Columbia almost to the Straits of Magellan in Chile.

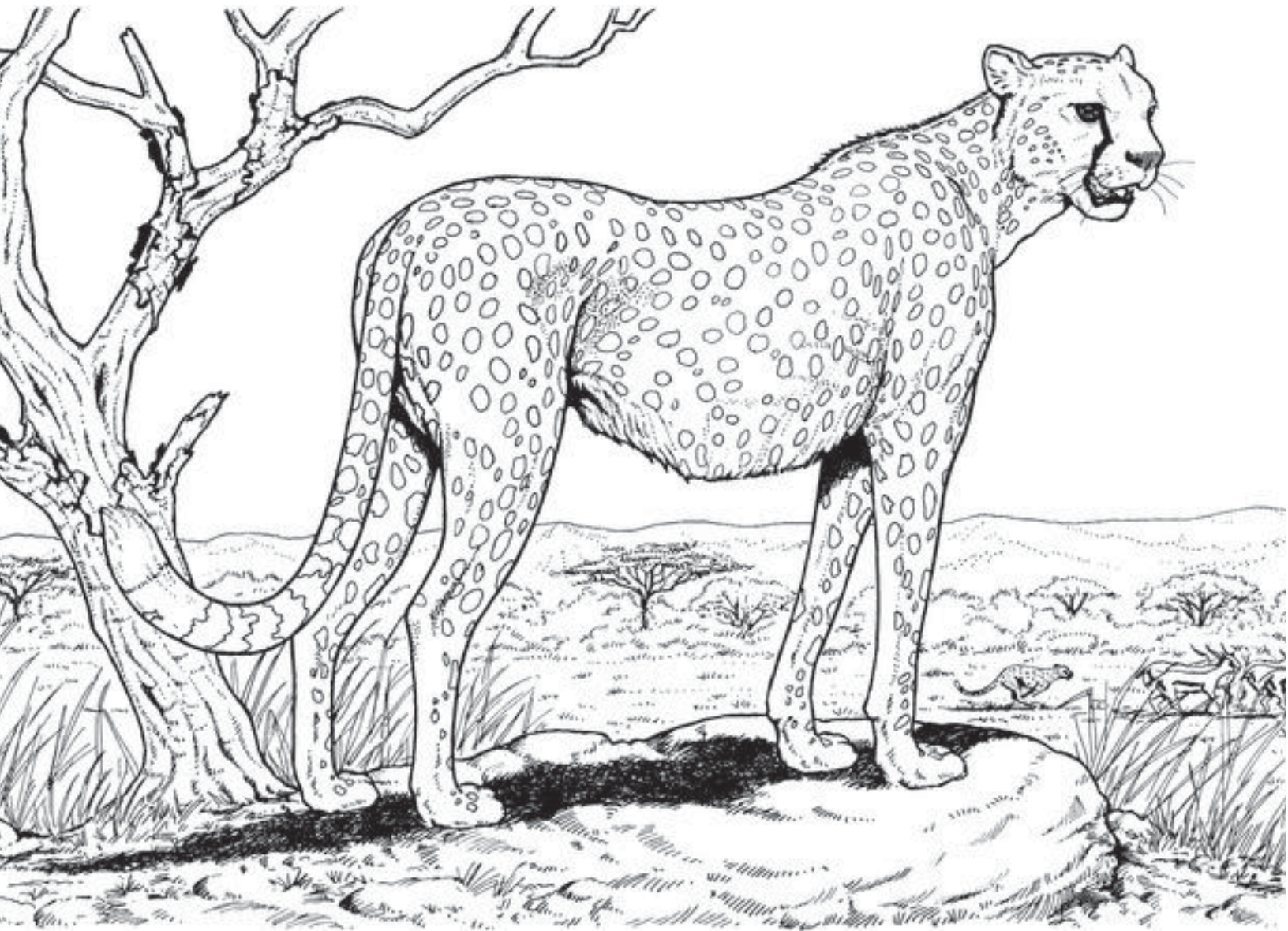
RANGE

Present in only 10% of its historical range. Largely restricted to isolated populations in protected areas of India, Nepal, Bhutan, Bangladesh, Thailand, Malaysia, Myanmar, Sumatra and Russia.

Weight: 29-64kg

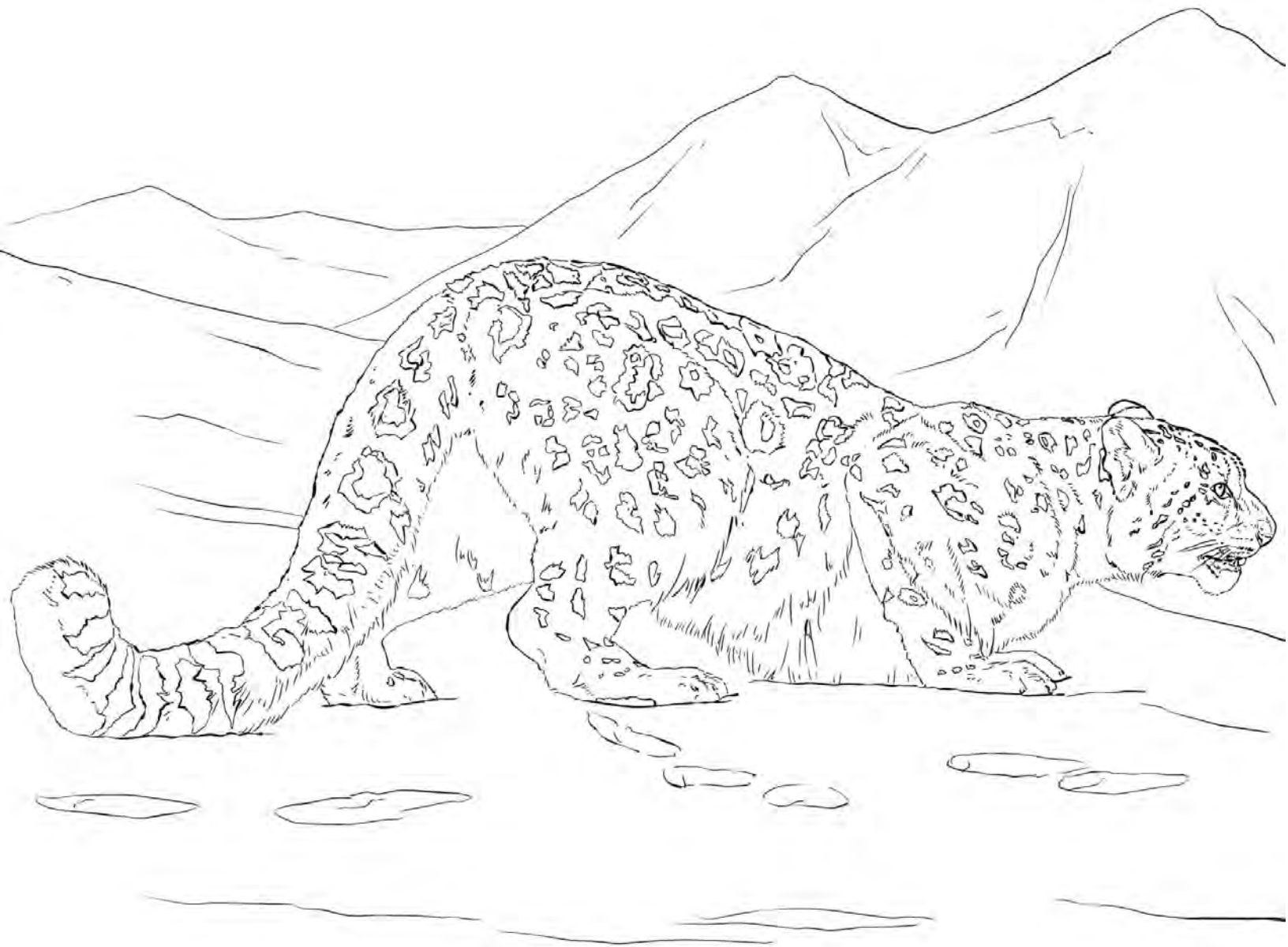
RANGE

Relatively widely distributed in southern and East Africa, rare to West and Central Africa and extinct in North Africa except southern Algeria. Extinct in Asia except for approximately 50 animals in central Iran.

Snow Leopard (*Panthera uncia*)

Vulnerable

PHYSICAL DETAILS

Length: 86-117cm
Weight: 21-53kg

Tail: 78-105cm

Male

Length: 104-125cm
Weight: 25-55kg

RANGE

Restricted to 12 countries in central Asia, from southern Russia to Uzbekistan and across through Mongolia and China. Species' distribution closely follows highest mountain ranges including the Himalayas.
